

DOLCE VITA PROGRAM

LAGO DI GARDA EST – 50 / 70 km



Lovely ride across the eastern bank of the lake, through the overhand hills, enjoying sightings and breath-taking views of the Monte Baldo slopes. Lunch in a local Trattoria in Albisano where is possible to taste Home made pasta, risotti and lake fish, in a garden with a fantastic view of the lake. Local cooking is similar to the one of Verona province plus the lake fish. Typical wine is the Bardolino Doc, a red fresh wine to be drunk young.

LAGO DI GARDA SUD – around 50/70 km



The tour that passes through the smooth southern hills of the lake across the sites of risorgimental battles, finally leads to the fortified Sirmione peninsula. The lunch will be served with your feet almost in the lake. Local cousin largely use the local fish together with the traditional one of Lombardia region. Lugana, white, fresh and fragrant wine and almonds and flowers scents, is the typical wine of the area. It is a blend of Trebbiano and minor grapes.

COLLINE MORENICHE – around 50 km



Easy tour passing through the southern hills of Garda lake. Centuries ago Della Scala, lords of Verona and Gonzaga from Mantova built several castles in this area in order to protect their armies and citizens, many of them are still on and families still live inside. Lunch is arranged in Valeggio sul Mincio at Pastificio Remelli, where will be visited the “laboratorio” with local women preparing tortellini, tortelli di zucca, tagliatelle e gnocchi, according to the tradition. Bianco di Custoza is the typical wine of the area. It is a fresh, light white wine to be drunk within one year from the production. It is a blend of Garganega and Trebbiano grapes.

VALTENESI WITH FERRY – around 75 km



Ride across the villages on the eastern side of the lake before ferrying to the western coast. From the ferry you will enjoy a fantastic view on Monte Baldo and the lake itself. Lunch will be on the beach at Moniga. Fish of the lake and fresh pasta are the core business of local cuisine. Doc Wine is red, Gropello, a fresh, light red one.

BICI & WINE VALPOLICELLA - around 70 km



Valpolicella area is entered passing Adige river. Valpolicella is well known for the quality of its blended wines basically reds. Amarone is one of the most important Italian wines, well structured, fully rounded 14-16°. It will be tasted, together with local cheese, salumi and mostarda, at Cantina Santa Maria Valverde, a 600 years old stone made compound with an outstanding view of the area.

VERONA CITTÀ – around 60 km



The city of Julietta and Romeo is entered following the Adige bike path from Bussolengo. Basilica di San Zeno starts the tour. The most important monuments (Roman, medieval, Venetian and Austrian-Hungarian) will be visited till the Arena. Lunch is in a typical pizzeria: "Little Italy". It is located in a small and nice square, 100 m from Juliet's balcony.

BICI & WHITE WINE – around 60 km



The castle of Monzambano is entered following the Mincio bike path, a former rail road connecting Mantova to Garda. The tour continues inbound Custoza, known for the battles of Risorgimento in 1848 and 1866. The monument called Ossario di Custoza was made to bury the bones of the soldiers founded in the area. Wine tasting will be served at Corte Quaiara of San Giorgio in Salici and zero kilometers ice cream will be enjoyed at Farm Corte Vittoria. Bianco di Custoza is the typical wine of the area. It is a fresh, light white wine, to be drunk within one year from the production (pron
