## CLASSIC RIDE

OUR CLASSIC RIDE IS FOR EXPERIENCED CYCLISTS  
WHO RIDE AT A MODERATE PACE

### CYCLIST TYPE

Cyclists capable of riding for several hours, including moderate climbs, comfortable riding on shared roads with cars and pedestrians

### TYPICAL RIDE

60-70 km (37-45 mi) ride, possibly with a climb

### AVERAGE SPEED

18-24 km/h (11-15 mi/h) av speed on flat

### SUGGESTED RENTAL BIKES

Pinarello Grevil, Pinarello Nitro e-bike, hybrid e-bikes

The Classic Ride is for experienced cyclists who ride at a moderate pace for a moderate distance. Classic rides feature rolling terrain and may have a longer climb of 3-4 km (1.5-2.5 miles), offering the perfect balance of challenge and enjoyment without being overly demanding.

Classic routes primarily follow quiet roads, but participants should feel confident riding alongside others in a group and navigating roads with light traffic when necessary.
